

Short Abstract:

When is root canal treatment indicated after trauma to a tooth?

Lecture 1.

Friday, OCT 7, 9:00Am - 10:30 Am

Trauma to a tooth can have various consequences with one of the most common being pulp necrosis and infection of the root canal system. However, this can occur at various times following trauma and it is dependent on many factors. There are some specific injuries where root canal treatment should be commenced immediately (or very soon after the injury) in order to improve the prognosis of the tooth or to prevent other complications such as external inflammatory resorption. Following some other injuries, root canal treatment should be avoided as this can be detrimental to the tooth's ability to recover and its long-term prognosis, especially if the tooth is not completely developed. These issues will be explored and recommendations will be provided for when root canal treatment should be performed after different types of traumatic dental injuries.

Strategies to manage local anesthesia of mandibular molars with irreversible pulpitis

Lecture 2.

Saturday, OCT 8, 8:00Am - 9:30 Am

Pain is one of the main reasons why patients seek dental treatment and many painful teeth will require root canal treatment. The fear of having pain during root canal treatment is one of the major factors that concerns patients about root. canal treatment. In addition, the presence of pre-operative pain is one of the main factors that contributes to patients experiencing pain during and after treatment. Hence, dentists must take care to ensure that the patient does not have any pain during treatment but this can be a significant challenge at times -such as when the tooth has acute irreversible pulpits and acute apical periodontitis, particularly when the tooth is a mandibular molar where standard local anesthetic techniques are not very effective. Hence, Dentists must have strategies to overcome this problem and typically a series of cascading steps need to be followed. Dentists should be familiar with alternate for supplementary) anaesthetic techniques that can be used in conjunction with the standard inferior alveolar block or infiltration techniques. The choice of which supplementary technique should be used will depend on the specific tooth being treated. Other strategies such as pre operative medication may also help in some cases. In this lecture, comprehensive strategies to achieve successful anesthesia of problematic teeth will be outlined together with some new injection techniques. These strategies are based on research by the presenter's group, particularly for acute irreversible pulpitis.

'cases has drastically increased in last decade. This lecture aims to present an explicative case series representative of several complex clinical situations in Endodontics solved using the ideal approach and to describe techniques and clinical tips to treat such cases.

Restoration of **Endodontically treated teeth**



The restoration of endodontically treated teeth is a topic that has been extensively studied in the literature, but which nevertheless remains controversial. This lecture aims to emphasize the characteristics of endodontically treated teeth and some principles to be observed when planning the restoration of these elements. The amount of residual coronal structure and the functional requirements are the main parameters to be analyzed to determine the best way to restore these elements, evaluating the material to be used, the possibility of performing direct or indirect restorations and associated or not with the insertion of a post. We will describe the most current strategies, tools and techniques to perform post-endodontic adhesive restorations and exploit their numerous clinical advantages, providing the basic principles for achieving long-term success. We will analyze the different possibilities for the restoration of endodontically treated teeth, the guidelines for post-endodontic restorations in anterior and posterior teeth and for the choice of direct or indirect restorations with and without fiber posts.
